

Rother Valley West Area Assembly has been working with members of the community to identify local needs and priorities, looking at ways of responding to those needs, and improving local service delivery.

Part of this new process has been through the devolved budget which is designed to help community/voluntary groups and statutory organisations in partnership with RMBC to improve the quality of life for local residents by positively responding to community issues.

Young people have worked in partnership with Rother Valley West Area Assembly and Thurcroft Parish Council by engaging in community consultation to identify a need to install flood lights on the existing multi-use games area in Thurcroft. £20,000 has been secured from Rother Valley West Devolved Budget and Neighbourhood Investment Team to provide the flood lights.

Thurcroft Parish Councils stated “we are delighted” that the flood lights will be installed on the purpose-built multi use games area which will give young people the opportunity to continue to use facilities in the darker months.
