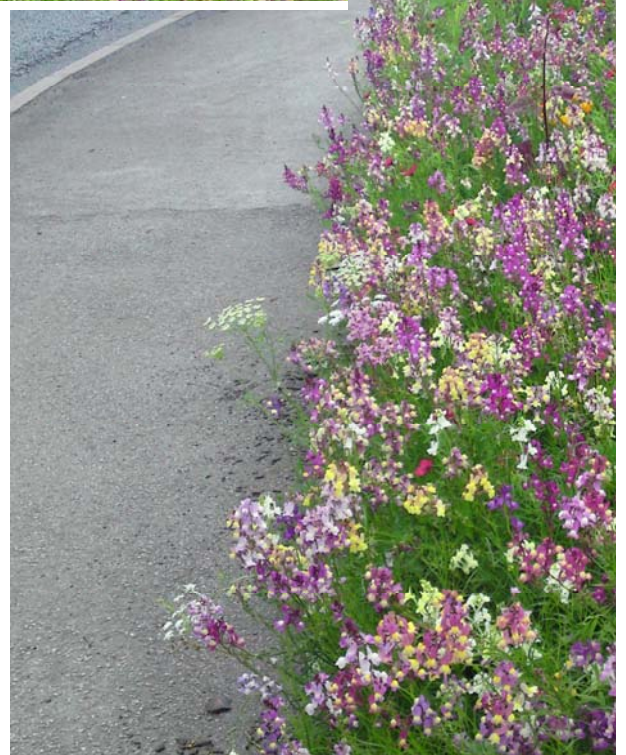


Warren Vale in Bloom

Summer 2009 has seen the approach to Swinton along Warren Vale Road transformed into a sea of colour, thanks to the beautiful array of wild flowers which were planted by Streetpride.

The decision to sow wild flowers as apposed to traditional bedding plants, bulbs or shrubs was one taken by RMBC Officers and Local Elected Members in the attempt to encourage more bees and insects to the area, as well as making this popular walking route more environmentally friendly and enjoyable for both pedestrians and motorists.



The flowers were paid for as part of the Gateway Project by the Housing Market Renewal Team.

These colourful native flowers have transformed the gateway into Swinton, and have become a topic of conversation for local people and visitors to the area.
