Jeanette Reed, Unit Leader, Winterhill YPC and several of the young people who attend the centre, presented a petition to the meeting in respect of the inactive street lighting on Little Common Lane and the issues this causes in respect of health and safety to staff and young people using the Winterhill YPC together with other members of the public who may need to use this right of way.

Pat Michael reported that she had been in contact with Paul Hudson, Technical Services Manager, Rotherham Schools PFI, who are currently working to restore lighting to this area and were hoping to have this problem resolved before Christmas.

4. Partners and Communities Together (PACT)

The current PACT priority areas are Ferham, Fellowsfield Way and St. John's Green. Sgt. Dave Baines gave a breakdown of the work done by the Safer Neighbourhood Team this month.

- Conducted Operation Creator dealing with acquisitive crime
- 26 people arrested for theft and drugs offences.
- A stolen vehicle was recovered during the operation.
- 18 uninsured vehicles were seized from owners.
- 35 Prohibition notices were served on unroadworthy vehicles.
- Conducted nuisance motorcycle operation 1 Admin 171 issued and stolen vehicle recovered.
- 15 Warning notices issued to addresses linked to ASB and an ABC issued .
- £10000 worth of stolen property recovered.
- 40 Units of alcohol seized that's equivalent to 20 pints of John Smiths.
